



Vibe Class Dress Code

The Vibe Performing Arts Center has the following dress code for class attire. The dress code helps all our students get the most out of each class they take. Please feel free to contact the front desk with any question you may have on the Class Dress Code. There are some items available for purchase at the Vibe Café, so be sure to check out the selection!

Ballet

All ballet classes will be required to wear a black leotard (student's choice), pink tights, and pink ballet slippers. Hair must be pulled up and secured into a bun. No jewelry.

Jazz, Contemporary and Lyrical

Jazz classes are open to students wearing any form fitting dance clothes with shoes the students can dance in. Foot Undeez or jazz shoes are popular choices. Hair should be pulled back away from face.

Ballroom

For all ballroom classes, proper ballroom shoes are required, and can be found online at several sources; including Dancelife, International, Supadance, or Capezio. Shoes are also available for purchase at the Vibe Café. For girls 12 years and younger the heel height is one and a half inches and a wide heel. For all others, the heel height is your own personal comfort level. Boy's shoes for 12 years and younger are the same. Talk to your ballroom teacher for more information about specific brand selections. Girls should wear a black skirt and gentleman should wear Latin slacks.

Hip Hop

Hip Hop classes are open attire as long as students can move in class. Please no tight jeans and please wear non marking shoes.

Tumbling

Bare feet is a must for tumbling class so no footed tights, socks, or shoes. Please no baggy clothes and have hair pulled back away from face.

Tap

Follow jazz class dress code with the addition of tap shoes.

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
